National Teams Coaches' Roles and Responsibilities

Code of Conduct

Each Coach selected to travel with any NC USA Wrestling Team is expected to be a role model for all of our athletes and to represent North Carolina USA Wrestling in a positive manner. Each Coach will also be assigned certain duties on a trip: bed checks, hall duty, general supervision, practice times, weight checks, etc. All Coaches are expected to help with all aspects of athlete supervision and to perform their assigned duties. Upon arrival to an event the Head Coach of that trip will determine and schedule duties for all coaches. Failure to perform assigned duties could result in removal from National Team Staff.

National Team trips are meant to be competition and learning experiences for our athletes and coaches, and are also meant to be rewarding experiences for year round hard work and dedication. It is understood that all coaches will perform their duties as role models. It is also understood that all coaches will carry themselves in a responsible manner and represent our state in a positive manner in social situations while not on duty. The main role of any Coach is to be role model for all athletes and to ensure the safety of all athletes; social activities of coaches are secondary to the needs of all athletes.

Duties

- General Supervision of Athletes – on the bus, at the hotel, at the venue, etc.
- Coaching of Assigned Athletes – and filling in anytime an athlete needs a coach.
- All Assigned Duties – to include: bed checks, hall duty, room inspections, weight checks, etc.
- Role Model for All Athletes – act in a responsible manner at all times while on team trips, interact with all athletes, give the wrestlers a good experience.

Consequences

Failure to perform all assigned and inherent responsibilities can lead to the dismissal of a coach from the National Team Staff. Any conduct unbecoming of a National Team Staff member will be reported to the State Director and Executive Board Members, who will then make a decision on the ability of the individual to continue to mentor our athletes and to continue to represent North Carolina USA Wrestling on Nation Team trips.
