**Entry Fee is \$20 for USA and NCAWAY members**

**Entry Fee for non-members is \$30.**

*NCAWAY memberships are valid at NUWAY / NCAWAY events and may be purchased by contacting Ed Duncan or Marty Bartram.*

**ALL ENTRIES WILL PAY \$20 AT THE TIME OF ONLINE REGISTRATION. USA AND NCAWAY MEMBERSHIPS MUST BE VERIFIED AT WEIGH-INS. NON-MEMBERS WILL PAY THE REMAINING \$10 OF THEIR ENTRY AT REGISTRATION**

You **must** wrestle your grade and may not "wrestle up" in either weight or age nor wrestle in two grades.

## COACHES & SPECTATOR INFORMATION

**USA Coaches memberships/floor pass:** Coaches must have a valid USA Coaches Card purchased at least five days prior to the event **OR** you may purchase a \$20 floor pass for the event. A coach membership is a season pass to USA Wrestling events and a floor pass at all NCUSA Events.

**Spectator Admission:** \$6.

**Parking:** \$6 per vehicle. Team buses may pick up free parking passes at registration Friday night.

**IMPORTANT!!!** No outside food or coolers are allowed in the arena. All bags will be searched prior to entry into arena.

## QUALIFYING INFORMATION

Wrestlers participating in this event are qualified to participate in the following:

**NC Schoolboy Dual Team (Birth Years 1996-97)**– Top 3 wrestlers of schoolboy age in each weight class will be eligible to wrestle off for the NC Schoolboy Dual Team. Wrestle offs will be held in May.

**USA National Folkstyle Championships (April 1)**  
Cedar Falls, IA– Any wrestler participating in the NC State Championships is eligible to participate in the USA National Folkstyle Championships.

## ELEMENTARY DIVISION INFORMATION

Team competition for the Elementary Division is based on NCAWA Clubs, **not schools.** All wrestlers used in team scoring must be registered under the correct team name. Clubs must be chartered for 09-10 season to be eligible for the team championships. Team Charters can be completed online OR at registration on Friday night if needed. Awards will be presented to the top two elementary division teams at the conclusion of the event. Grades 1 - 6 wrestle Folkstyle, grouping entrants by grade and weight.

## JR. HIGH DIVISION INFORMATION

Team competition for Jr. High division will be **based on schools.** All wrestlers used in team scoring must be registered under the correct team name. Bouts are 2-1-1 Championship Bracket, 1-1-1 Consolation.

A wrestler's **real school** is the wrestler's team, even if there is no team at the school.

Awards will be presented to the top two teams in the Jr. High Division at the conclusion of the tournament.

## OTHER INFORMATION

Only two coaches in a corner (wristbands required). Folkstyle mat rules, double elimination, no rematches. **Headgear required.** Singlets suggested, but not required. There is no seeding. We separate wrestlers from the same area as best we can.

The winner and his/her coach is responsible for checking bout sheet and signing it before leaving mat area.

You **must** be a designated club/team coach to coach or a Current USA registered coach to coach in this event.
